## 1.PHYSICAL WELL BEING OF THE CHILDREN:

### SANITATION CAMPAIGN:

The organization organized a sanitation rally on 31<sup>st</sup> march'11. There were about 100 school students and children club's children

were participated in the program. **The objective of this rally was**

- To emphasis on generating awareness among the different communities in villages.
  - To bring about behavior change in the rural communities regarding clean surrounding and sanitation facilities.
  - To provide health education to students and develop habit of cleanliness in them
- The rally started at 8.M and covered 5 villages of Sahaspur block in the district of Dehradun. refreshment was served all the participated.

### AWARENESS ON HIV/AIDS AND T.B:

*The organization conducted awareness program on HIV/AIDS and T.B on 10<sup>th</sup> October'10. Dr. A.Khanduri was resource person for the program. There were 150 people from different communities got together for this program. The program was conducted at new life academy at Redapur. Dr. khanduri told that India is projected to become the eye of the storm for AIDS epidemic in the world. He said that human*



*Immunodeficiency virus that gradually damages the body's immune system and eventually causes AIDS. The common misperceptions about the transmission are:*

- *Living in the same place with people who have HIV/AIDS.*
- *Kissing, touch-hugging, shaking hands, supports contact.*
- *Sharing food utensils, cups or dishes.*
- *Sweat, saliva or tear*
- *Urine or feces.*

*He said that 2% of the population suffers from TB among these the number of persons with infections tuberculosis is 0.4%.In a population of 100 there may be 4 infectious persons from whom disease can spread to others.T.B is caused by germs and the commonest part of the body affected is the lungs. When a person suffering from T.B cough he/she brings out millions of T.B germs, these germs are taken in other persons while breathing, and the disease spreads. There are 500 people die due to T.B every day. T.B can be cured if the person continue medicine for prescribe period. All the medicine is availed in all the government hospitals. In uttrakhand in every 1 lakhs there 200-300 people affected with T.B. The organization try to bring awareness and find out new affected person and net work with government hospital to help them get rid of from this sickness. We also conducted debate competition on HIV/AIDS and T.B and awarded them with prizes.*

**HEALTH CAMP:**

The organization organized health camp at New life Academy at Redapur on 15<sup>th</sup> Feb'11. There were about 200 people came for health check-up. Dr. A. khanduri who is the medical officer in primary health centre at sahaspur block was the resource person for the program. The meeting was started by word of welcome by Mr. Stephen mashi. Then the doctor told about the factors that influences on health and hygiene, nutrition and healthy habits. He also shared about First aid, anti-natal care, post natal care and identification of local medicinal plants and their uses. Right after the lunch the health check up stated and medicines were distributed according doctor's advice. Dr. khanduri recommended some of people those are supposed to go through different test to Dehradun



government hospital.



**DISABILITY PROGRAM:**

*The disability program was arranged on 15<sup>th</sup> October'10 at Banjara basti. Mr. Harikesh mishra who is village development officer was*



*the chief guest for the program. There were 100 people took active participation in the program. The purpose of this program is to bring the ray of smile on the faces of disability people. Mr. Harikesh shared about different government schemes for disability people. The meeting was closed right after the lunch for all participants.*

## **11. INTELLECTUAL WELL BEING OF THE CHILDREN**

### **NEW LIFE ACADEMY:**

*The society started an English medium school for the poorest of poor children in the weaker section of the society those are not able to enroll in the public school due to high fees structure. There 70 children are form minority, dalit and beggar's communities.*

### **CHILD DEVELOPMENT:**

*There are 5 new life children club's among Muslim, Banjara and Sapera community. There 150 children in our clubs. The clubs are establish with aim of empowering children in the areas of education, saving habits, values, health and hygiene and the protection of environment. The children clubs are very active to ensure there will no child should be illiterate in their respective villages. We teach children regarding Moral values, mannerism and child right etc .we also provide them sport materials for sound health and encourage them to be responsible citizen of our nation.*

### **ADULT LITERACY PROGRAM:**

*Adult literacy is pivotal to the nation of India as illiteracy impedes individual and nation growth. 65%-70% of rural India is non-literate and 40% live below poverty line. There are five literacy centers in our target area. The training, curriculum materials, methodology and programs envisioned and implement by partnership with like minded NGOs have had immense influence and brought visible changes among the non-literate who suffer multiple privations. Primarily learners literacy level increased to 5<sup>th</sup> grade, awareness on social evils and knowledge on health on issues helped to address them directly. Reasonable economic and moral development was also realized. All this is achieved in one year's program time.*



## **11.1. SOCIO-ECONOMIC WELL BEING OF THE CHILDREN:**

### **AGRICULTURAL & ENVIRONMENT PROGRAM:**

*The organization has organized organic farming and environment awareness program on 26th August'10. There were 90 farmers from 6 different villages attended this program. Mr. Atar singh who was resource person for the program shared about the benefits of using organic compost which is ultimately benefit for our environment as well as for our health. Atar singh is always ready to extend his helping hand if any of the farmer willing to adopt this method. The organization is looking forward to establish farmers' club in order to ensure use of organic compost in their respective villages. Lunch was arranged for all those who attended this program.*

### **AWARENESS ON FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS & CULTURAL PROGRAM:**



This program was organized on 15<sup>th</sup> August'10. Mr. Harikesh Mishra was the resource person for the program. There were 50 people were invited for the program. The object of this program was to bring awareness on cultural and fundamental rights so that it will help them to understand as the citizen of this country what are their duty and responsibility to fulfill and help other to do so. At the end of the program Refreshment and lunch were served to all the participants.

#### **SEMINAR ON INCOME GENERATION AND CARRIER COUNSELING:**

The society has conducted seminar on income generation for youth on 24<sup>th</sup> November'10. There were about 50 youth joined in the program. Mr. Stephen mashi was the resource person for this program. The purpose this seminar was to bring awareness of different schemes of government and private sectors where youths can start their carrier. Today after finishing their study most of the youths think that they are useless, here is the opportunity for the society to guide them where they can go and to have secure future. This year the organization helped 50 youth to join in different companies in the state of uttrakhand.

#### **AWARENESS ON CHILD LABOUR AND CHILD RIGHTS:**

The program was conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> sepember'10. Mr. R.k William was the resource person. There were 100(children, village leaders and community elders) joined in the program. The purpose of this program was to bring awareness and motivate village leaders to ensure there will be no child labor or rag pickers in their villages. Secondly to identify these kinds of children and ensure them that they must be enroll in school for their bright future. The resource person said that there are 67 million Indian children do not have access to basic education and 47% are girls. India is has the largest number of street children in the world, 18 million out of 1 billion .75% of the children never received any vitamin drops. The aim of this program was eradication of child labor in our target area.



#### **SELF HELP GROUP FARMATION:**

This program was conducted on 22<sup>nd</sup> February '11. There were 100 women took active participation in the discussion. The purpose of this program was to form self help group in our target villages in order to get rid of from the moneylender. The resource person was Mr. Atar singh who shared how to form the group and how this group can be channel of blessing for their own community. They can have loaning system with low interest with in the member of the group. The group can start small cottage industry with help of bank loan for sustainable future and better living standard.

#### **AWARENESS ON SOCIAL ISSUES:**

This program was organized on 20<sup>th</sup> Sept'10. There were 200 people attended this program. These were some of issues high lighted in the program such as child marriage, infanticide, abortion, child abuse, dowry, domestic violence and child labor etc. Mrs. Piyus William was the resource person for the

program. She shared briefly about those topics. Her emphasis was as community how we can work together to get rid of these problems. It was wonderful time for all the participated.

#### **COMPUTER TRAINING:**

This year the organization is able to help three youth for computer training. All of them successfully completed the course and involved in part time job.

#### **VOCATIONAL TRAINING:**

The organization organized vocational training for 60 women. The training was conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> November'10. Mr. Stephen mashi was the resource person for the program. The purpose of this training was to help and encouraged our target women to learn and start their petty business for better living standard and they can use the same items in their home in cheaper price compared to market price. During the training period following things were taught 1.surf 2.phenyl 3.shampoo 4.balm 5.Jam 6.candle and liquid soap .We encouraged them to form self help group and start to collect some particular amount so that they can continue their business. All the participated were happy and willing to form group so that in the group they can start this kind of items for better living standard.

#### **WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT:**

The society purchase three sewing machines for opening tailor centre .There are two centers are going on. One is at Sahaspur and other one is in Indarpuri. There are 25 women are going through the training. The training will help them to increase their income for better living standard.



#### **1V.MORAL WELL BEING OF THE CHILDREN**

##### **HARMONIOUS COMMUNITY:**

This program was organized on 24<sup>th</sup> December '10 at Sahaspur block. The purpose of this program was to bring harmony among different communities regardless of religion, caste, race, ethnicity or gender. India is democratic and secular in matters of religious, belief and practice, justice, liberty and equality are secured to all the citizens with out religious distinctions. There were 200 people from different communities and religious background joined in the program. Dr. Harihar pothal the Director of "Life for all "talked about how to live in peace and harmony among different communities with peace and harmony. Right after the program refreshment and lunch served for all the participated.
